Community Care RxSM Medicare Part D Plan Surpasses 1,000,000 Enrollments

CLEVELAND (March 21, 2006) – MemberHealth, Inc. announced today that Community Care RxSM (CCRx), its Medicare Part D Prescription Drug Plan, has enrolled more than 1,000,000 Medicare beneficiaries. CCRx is one of 10 national Medicare-approved prescription drug programs available to Medicare beneficiaries in the United States, Puerto Rico, and the United States Virgin Islands. More than 59,500 pharmacies participate in the CCRx network.

CCRx, a collaborative effort among MemberHealth, Computer Sciences Corporation, and the National Community Pharmacists Association (NCPA), offers an appealing benefit to Medicare beneficiaries with substantial cost-savings on prescriptions, a broad formulary, extensive national pharmacy network, and accessibility to a dedicated call center. CCRx will roll out its medication therapy management component of the Medicare Part D benefit via face-to-face pharmacist-patient encounters beginning in June 2006, providing a value-added opportunity for qualifying patients to receive comprehensive medication reviews from their pharmacists.
